* PENNSYLVANIA AMERICAN LEGION SCHOLARSHIPS

Deadlines: Vary

<u>Sebastianelli Drum Corps Scholarship</u> – Open to any senior who is a child or grandchild of a PA Legionnaire living or deceased. The student must be a member of a high school band and is going on to higher education with a major in music. <u>Joseph P. Gavenonis Scholarship</u> – Open to any PA high school senior who is a child of a PA Legionnaire. The student needs to be seeking a four year degree in a PA college or University.

<u>Robert W. Valimont Endowment</u> – Open to any PA high school senior who is a child of a PA Legionnaire. The student needs to be seeking a two year career-oriented education or training in a less-than-four-year program in a PA school. CLARENCE SCHOCK FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Scholarships are awarded in the amount of \$6,600 and payable as follows: \$1,200 freshman year,

\$1,600 sophomore year, \$1,800 junior year and \$2,000 senior year. Ask about this scholarship when visiting or contacting one of the following universities. Each university is responsible for selection of candidates in accordance with the university's own policies and practices.

PRUDENTIAL SPIRIT OF COMMUNITY AWARDS

Deadline: November 7, 2017

The Prudential Spirit of Community Awards has become the county's largest and most prestigious recognition program for middle level and high school youth (in grades 5-12) who volunteer in their communities. Students have until November 7, 2017 to apply online through http://spirit.prudential.com or www.nassp.org/spirit. After submitting their applications electronically, students must also send their applications to their school principal (either electronically or by hand). Their principal will then select the school's top applicant(s). To qualify you must have a minimum of 50 hours for students under 15 and 100 hours for those older of volunteer hours.

COMCAST LEADERS AND ACHIEVERS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Deadline: November 30, 2017

One UDA Senior may be nominated for this \$1,000 award. GPA of 2.8 or higher is required. Interested seniors should submit to Mrs. Heinbach a list of school and community activities as well as a paragraph explaining the volunteer work completed and leadership shown in school and in the community. Applicants will be judged on their strong commitment to and involvement in community service. Applicants must demonstrate leadership abilities in school activities or through work experience.

Deadline: December 6, 2017

* PENNSYLVANIA RESTAURANT ASSOCIATION EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

Deadline: March 1, 2018

Graduating High School Seniors furthering their education in the hospitality industry who have been accepted in a Hospitality or Culinary Arts program in an accredited post-secondary institution, Students currently enrolled in an accredited program and reside in Pennsylvania are eligible for this scholarship. Requirements include completed application form, three letters of recommendation, transcript, short essay (200 words) describing who you are, your work experience and why you wish to pursue a career in the hospitality industry, letter of acceptance from school, hospitality work experience preferred but not required and a personal interview may be required to receive an award. * UNITED STEELWORKERS OF AMERICA HUGH CARCELLA SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline: March 15, 2018.

Six, four year scholarships, each with a total value of \$4,000 (\$1,000 per year) available. Scholarships will be available for use in an accredited college or university within the USA or Canada. Winners may follow any course of study normally leading to a recognized bachelor's degree. Applicant must be the son, daughter or legal ward of a member of a United Steelworkers, District 10 (Eastern) local union or are the son or daughter or legal ward of a disabled or old age retiree or deceased member of an affiliated local union who was in good standing with the United Steelworkers at the time of their retirement or death. Deadline: April 30, 2018
