CLARENCE SHOCK FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Scholarships are awarded in the amount of \$6,600 and payable as follows: \$1,200 freshman year, \$1,600 sophomore year, \$1,800 junior year and \$2,000 senior year. Ask about this scholarship when visiting or contacting one of the following universities. Each university is responsible for selection of candidates in accordance with the university's own policies and practices.
