**RE:** **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION/SCREENING for 2018-19 SCHOOL YEAR**

The Upper Dauphin Area Elementary School will be holding Kindergarten Registration for the 2018-19 school year for any child who has not started school and will be five (5) years of age on or before September 1, 2018.

Registration/screening will be held on Wednesday April 25, Thursday April 26 and Friday April 27, 2018. Registration will be held on each day from 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM. Please call the Upper Dauphin Area Elementary School at 362-6619 to make an appointment for registration. Please plan on being at registration for one (1) hour.

On the above dates, speech, vision and kindergarten readiness screenings will be given to your child. Parents should bring their child, child's birth certificate, social security card, immunization records (requirements as follows) and proof of residency(requirements as follows):

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has school immunization requirements. The regulations require children entering kindergarten for the 2018-19 school year have the following immunizations:

- Three doses of hepatitis B vaccine
- Four doses of polio with 4<sup>th</sup> dose administered on or after one's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday
- A second dose of measles vaccine, preferably given as Measles, Mumps, Rubella(MMR)
- A fourth dose of tetanus and diphtheria vaccine, including one dose administered on or after one's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday
- Two doses of Varicella (chickenpox vaccine)

Proof of residency will be required at your registration appointment in order to finalize your child's enrollment. Please review the list of required documents. Contact the Elementary School Office if you have any questions. Proof of residence in the Upper Dauphin Area School District is defined as:

- A Pennsylvania Driver's License, Pennsylvania Photo Identification Card or Passport containing your current address within the Upper Dauphin Area School District.
- One (1) of the following:
  - Homeowner: Deed for a residential property within the Upper Dauphin Area School District, settlement document or sales agreement, or
  - Renter: A lease or notarized affidavit from the homeowner showing occupancy of a residence within the Upper Dauphin Area School District.
- If you do not have any of the documents listed above, then you must present two (2) of the following:
  - Proof of property tax return indicating the address within the Upper Dauphin Area School District.
  - Current check stub for wages, public assistance, social security or other source of income indicating the address within the Upper Dauphin Area School District.
  - Payment or proof of liability for payment for municipal or school district taxes for an improved property within the Upper Dauphin Area School District.
  - Current utility bill indicating payment for a utility due to occupancy of a residence within the Upper Dauphin Area School District.
