UPPER DAUPHIN AREA ENHANCED REMOTE EDUCATION

Each student will be issued a district iPad, protective case, and charger.

Expectations	Students will be expected to attend and participate in school EVERY day. Students are allowed to complete the daily learning activities outside the normal school hours as long as they meet the required due dates. Students will not be required to attend live instruction. Live instruction may occasionally be offered, but those sessions will also be recorded for later access. In general, teachers will record their lessons and post on Google Classroom along with assignments. Due to the flexible nature and independent motivation required to be successful in a remote learning environment, all students may not be suited for this type of learning. Our counseling department will continue to offer support, tips and tools to address any concerns. If students are not successful with remote learning, we may recommend they return to in-person instruction.
Access to Teachers	Teachers will be able to provide guidance to students in the Enhanced Remote Education Program during normal school hours. While work may be completed outside of those hours, teachers will only be available during the school day. Each teacher will provide academic support information/hours/procedure as part of the Google Classroom. Teacher schedules vary and response times may also vary.
Special Education	Students will be assigned a case manager that will oversee and/or facilitate Special Education programming. The Educational team will collaborate to revise the current IEP to reflect Enhanced Remote Education, while maintaining access to a Free Appropriate Public Education
Technology Support	Instructional videos will be available on the district website for each tool being used. Technical issues will be managed by the student help desk. The Help Desk email is helpdesk@kids.udasd.org
Parent Participation	We recommend that you request access to your child's Google Classroom. Please email your child's teachers to gain access. While we encourage parent support, please remember that students are responsible for completing their own work. Assignment and grade information will also be viewable on the Sapphire Community Portal for all students including students in the Enhanced Remote Education Program.
Lunches	Every Wednesday from 1:30-2:30 PM, remote learners will be provided the opportunity to drive through the elementary bus circle to pick up a week's worth of breakfasts and lunches. Students will be issued ID cards which must be presented to receive the lunches. If students qualify for free or reduced lunches, those qualifications still apply, otherwise the charge will be full meal price.
Attendance	Daily attendance will be taken through the Google Classroom and updated in Sapphire. All attendance/truancy laws apply to remote learners.
Grading	Grading for Enhanced Remote Education will be the same as in-person learning.
Returning to School	The UDASD requests a week notice for parents who choose to send their child back to in-person instruction.
