

# CHANGING THE MODEL

UDASD School Board Proposal to the MASD School Board

The Upper Dauphin Area School District will offer tuition to Millersburg Area School District high school students (grades 9-12) to attend high school at the UDASD High School campus for the 2022-2023 school year and beyond.

## THE BENEFITS:

- 01 This solution would eliminate the need to build or renovate the existing Lenkerville Elementary
- 02 Keep a community-based school for K-8 students within the MASD and adds space for those students
- 03 High school students would experience enhanced course and curriculum offerings available through the UDASD High School
- 04 UDASD would hire approximately fifteen teachers from MASD High School to fill curricular gaps as needed
- 05 Utilizes an existing model which has been proven to work in other regional districts
- 06 The present MASD governing school board would remain intact
- 07 High school students attending UDASD High School was the solution proposed in Option 5 of the Merger Plan
- 08 Time and cost for transporting MASD students to UDASD High School is within a manageable range due to the location of the high school.
- 09 Students are already working together at the high school level within sports cooperative
