November 19th & November 26th Have dinner at Swing of Lykens Valley

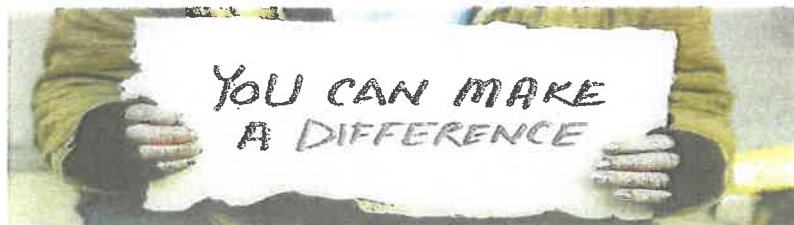
Come out for dinner between 4:00pm-9:00pm and Swing will give 10% of all food sales to help our local homeless in Northern Dauphin.

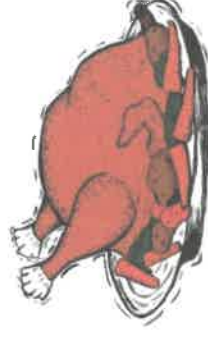
