Hello, UDA families!

Pennsylvania school law requires all children to have a physical examination in **kindergarten, sixth grade, and eleventh grade**. If your student is currently a kindergartener, sixth, or eleventh grader, the school nurse must have a documented physical exam for your child. It is recommended that a family physician completes the examination report for school records because your physician has a familiar knowledge of your child's medical history. If your family physician has examined your child within the past year, please send a copy of the examination to school. A copy of the private physical exam can be found [here](#).

If desired, the school physician can perform the needed physical examination required by PA state law at no cost to you. On **Wednesday, April 13th, 2022**, Dr. Douglas Charles will visit the district to perform physical examinations for students who have not yet received a physical exam to meet their school requirement. If a completed physical is not received prior to April 13th, your child will be scheduled to be seen by Dr. Charles at school.
